REASON FOR THIS AWARD

During Ed Stein's two-year term as president of the South Jersey Men's Club, throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, Ed did a remarkable job keeping SJMC a vibrant organization that served its members and the South Jersey Jewish community. Although in-person meetings could not be held, Ed ensured that SJMC held its monthly meetings via Zoom, featuring such programs as a live virtual tour of Jerusalem and a presentation about COVID by an infectious disease specialist.

Through various efforts, Ed saw to it that SJMC donated \$15,000 to the Jewish Federation of Southern New Jersey to help it deal with COVID. Also, Ed was very active in ensuring that SJMC helped prepare and deliver packages for the Betty and Peter Fischer Food Pantries, placed flags at the graves of Jewish veterans as part of Memorial Day, and distributed Yom Hashoah candles as part of the Southern New Jersey's Holocaust memorial program.
